While it is our goal to accommodate everyone, please note registrations will not be processed during the month of September or on the first day of class. It is impossible to successfully ask for volunteer catechists without knowing the number of students at each grade level. Therefore, class sizes and volunteers will be determined as of August 31st. After that date, only available spaces will be filled. This means your child may have to wait until October or later to get a space in class.

### Frequently Asked Questions

When will I receive notification of class dates and times? Letters with the class schedule will be mailed to your home shortly after Labor Day.

When do classes begin and when are they held? Classes for Grades 5-8 and Grades 9 and up begin in September and are typically held on Sunday nights on a monthly basis.

What is the structure of the classes? For grades 5-8 we use the Scripture Walk Series. The goal of Scripture Walk is to study the Bible consistent with Catholic scriptural interpretation and to put these teachings into action. These are active sessions, and are followed with pizza or other refreshments and games. For grades 9 and up we use a 2 year series covering the basics of our Catholic faith. In addition we rotate classes with speakers on relevant topics.

My child cannot attend today's scheduled Youth Ministry class. Who should I notify? Please call 518-346-4926 ext. 121 and leave a message. If you do not call us, we will make every attempt to call you if your child is not in class to verify your child's safety and whereabouts. Note that for those students preparing to enter Immediate Preparation for Confirmation there is an attendance requirement. Being in attendance means being at class during the entire class time. If a student has three absences without excuse your child will be removed from the program until we can verify the reason for absence.

What is VIRTUS Training and must I attend? VIRTUS training is a sexual abuse awareness training required by the Diocese for all adults working with children. All catechists over the age of 18 have undergone a background check and attended VIRTUS training and wear a badge indicating so. All parents are encouraged to do the same so that they may also volunteer with children. Not being VIRTUS trained does not stop you from visiting your child's classroom, however you will not be allowed to be in a position where you are working with other children in an unsupervised setting.

For various reasons my child has not attended Youth Ministry classes and is now interested in joining. How should I begin? Children (and adults) can begin Youth Ministry classes in a variety of entry points. According to our cluster policy, at a minimum, students must receive 2 years of High School level Youth Ministry classes prior to entering Immediate Preparation for Confirmation. Please call our offices and we will work with your child's individual needs.

I understand my child must complete Service Hours to receive Confirmation. How does this work? Our baptismal call requires us to provide service to others. In the same way we learn about Jesus' teachings, we must also learn how to put His teaching into action. Students can begin accumulating Service Hours in 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Plenty of opportunities are available through the church, such as baking for church events, volunteering at the annual Festa, volunteering as an aide in a classroom, to name a few. Students must also volunteer in the community either on their own or through church sponsored activities such as walks for charitable causes or volunteering to play bingo with residents at a local nursing home. Worksheets are available to help keep track of these hours. Most importantly, students should not see this as a requirement for Confirmation, but as establishing a Christian lifestyle.

At this time I cannot pay the fees associated with the program but want to keep my child enrolled in the program. What are my options? No one will be turned away due to the inability to pay the fees associated with the program. If there are financial difficulties, please contact the Faith Formation Office and alternative arrangements will be made. These arrangements may include a monthly payment plan, a request for a reduced fee, or a request for a full scholarship. All information will be held in the strictest of confidence.
